MARKER POLICY:

It is the sole responsibility of the customer to purchase and supply their own marker. As per the Health and Safety Code § 9052 (d), the District is prohibited to sell, manufacture or furnish monuments/markers.

	<u>All Granite</u>	<u>With 3" Border</u>
Single	16" x 28" x 3"	12" x 24" x 3" (18" x 30" x 3")
Double	18" x 40" x 3"	14" x 36" x 3" (20" x 42" x 3")

Only flat markers, laid flush with the ground, shall be accepted by the Murrieta Valley Cemetery District. All solid granite markers **must** have a lawn mower proof edge (L.M.P.). No delivered marker will be accepted without the appropriate setting fee. **Only District personnel may set the markers.**

Care of the marker is the sole responsibility of the family. While we use as much caution and care as possible to protect all markers, the District shall not be liable for scratches, fading and/or other damage to any marker. **All occupied gravesites will receive a temporary marker for up to three months which may be removed after that time.**

I/we agree to place a marker observing the above specifications as set forth by the Murrieta Valley Cemetery District.

FLOWER POLICY:

All flowers will be removed from gravesites on Wednesdays.

No flowers will be removed the week prior to and following holidays: Easter, Mother's Day, Memorial Day, Father's Day, 4th of July, Veterans Day, Thanksgiving and Christmas.

No miscellaneous items such as glass, ceramic or breakable flower containers/vases, balloons especially Mylar, wind chimes/socks, lawn ornaments, etc. are allowed.
