

MURRIETA VALLEY CEMETERY DISTRICT

NICHE WALL POLICY

1. Only one (1) large urn per Niche or two (2) minimal size urns.
2. All fees must be paid in full prior to placement. No placement shall be allowed in which payment has not been received in full. There is a \$25.00 fee for any check returned by the bank. A service which shall be held within 72 hours or less may require a cashier's check for payment.
3. The cemetery must be provided one (1) working days notice in advance of any placement.
4. All services shall be concluded by 2:00PM. Due to personnel limitations the District allows only one (1) burial per day.
5. No placement shall be permitted in the cemetery until a properly signed burial permit is delivered to the General Manager, District Secretary or a member of the Board of Trustees.
6. Murrieta Valley Cemetery District does **not** provide any service on the weekend.
7. **It is the sole responsibility of the customer to purchase and supply their own marker.** A 7.00" x 3.00" bronze marker may be placed on the face of the Niche wall only. There shall be one name per marker allowed and up to two markers per niche. While the District uses as much caution and care as possible to protect all markers, the District shall not be liable for any damage to any marker.
8. Glass objects, balloons, wind chimes, **stickers**, etc. are **not** allowed for the niche wall. Only the Board approved flower vase may be placed on a niche. No other adornment may be placed upon the niche door. The District is not responsible for said flower vase. Artificial flowers no longer than 6 inches in length are allowed. All flowers are removed on Wednesdays with the exception of the major holidays.
9. In the event of adverse weather conditions in which the duties associated with opening/closing and/or funeral services are unsafe, a placement will be rescheduled.
10. Niches shall be reserved or placed on hold for a **period of 30 days** and shall become eligible for resale after that period with no further notice.
11. The Board of Trustees and/or staff does hereby reserve the right to exclude or remove any headstone, marker, monument or other structure, tree, plant or any object it shall consider in any way objectionable or detrimental to the appearance of the cemetery.
12. Except by order of the Court, no removal of an urn shall be allowed except on written authority of the niche plot owner. In the case of urn removal, all required permits and fees must be executed, paid, and delivered to the General Manager, District Secretary or a member of the Board of Trustees.

The aforementioned **RULES AND REGULATIONS** are in effect as of July 27, 2010 and are subject to change as deemed necessary by the Board of Trustees.
